1. Scientific communication has a variety of impacts on mentees.
2. Be an engaged mentor: Set expectations early and practice accountability.
3. Create opportunities for speaking, presenting, and writing.
4. Don't wait until the big manuscript or presentation.
5. Discuss your mentee's specific strengths, weaknesses, and perceptions about writing and speaking.
6. You don't have to "fix" everything to be a good scientific communication mentor.
7. Get additional support and resources.
